ICOM UK TRAVEL BURSARIES

Travel Bursary Fund

- Up to £1,000 to attend a relevant international conference
- £5,000 available each calendar year
- Awarded on a first-come-first-served basis (4 x deadlines each year)
- Only open to ICOM UK members

Camilla Boodle Bursary Fund

- Up to £250 to extend an international visit
- Covers local costs for study tours, research projects, museum visits etc.
- Does not cover cost of international travel or conference attendance
- Awarded on a first-come-first-served basis (no fixed deadlines)
- Only open to ICOM UK members
