# ICOM UK Membership report 2020/01

### FIRST QUARTERLY REPORT

#### Headlines

- Closing figures for 2019 included an overall net growth for ICOM UK of 14%, with an overall increase in membership of 328
- Applications for 2020 opened in mid-October 2019
- Individual members currently include 948 regular, 446 retired and 336 student members, including 288 new members joining to date
- Institutional members include 53 in total, with 5 new institutions joining to date
- ICOM HQ have indicated some inconsistency between our own member figures and the numbers held by them. This is under discussion and likely to result from issues within their dataset.
- Be end December 2020, we have achieved 1783 members in total, with a value of £155,629. The same period last year achieved 1424 members /£122,151 value

#### **Actions**

- New target budget for 2020 membership income is £210,000, suggested target numbers for each member category are included below (Table 3).
