Headlines

- NB All income data is shown <u>before</u> payment processing fees applied by Stripe
- Membership applications and renewals slowed down from COVID-19 lockdown
- Renewals and applications have been successfully brought into the first half of the year
- Current membership figures for 2020 have been met and exceed 2020 income target
 - TARGET: £211,190 from 2370 members (2295 IND / 75 INST)
 - 2020: £217,224 from 2418 members (2338 IND / 80 INST)
- In 2020, 541 new members: 534 INDs and 7 INSTs, combined value £36,683
- Retention of INDs is good: 80% of 2019 members have renewed (Table 4)
 - Comprising 88% Regular / 98% Retired / 46% Students / 75% Supporting
 - As a guide >80% is good and student retention is expected to be <50%
- Retention of INSTs is high, with 96% of the target shown in Table 3 renewing to date.
- Net Growth has dropped in 2020, with growth in numbers at 4% compared to 14% in 2019 and 19% in 2018 (Table 5).

- Agree new targets for 2021
- Review membership strategy and targets with consideration of COVID-19 impacts
